

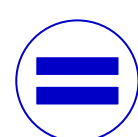
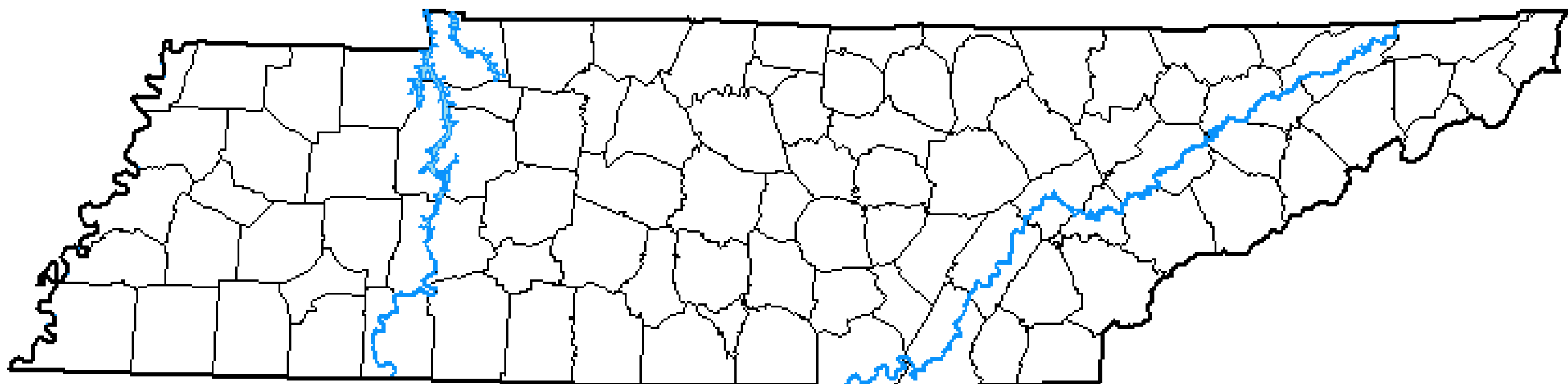
Tennessee Drought Update

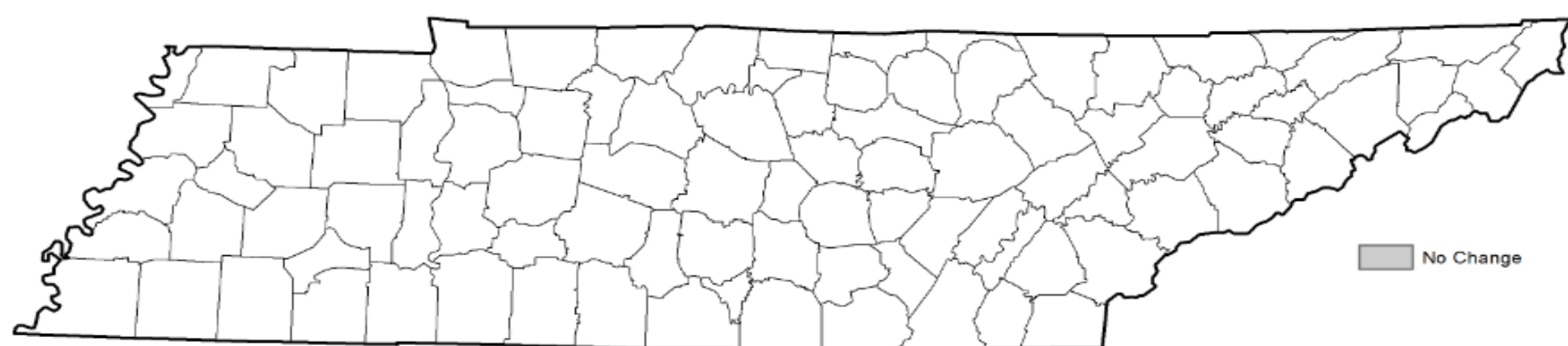
With most of the state recording above average rainfall amounts and cooler temperatures, Tennessee remains free of any drought conditions.

What's Changed? With above average rainfall amounts in most counties in 2023 so far, there were no changes across Tennessee.

What's New? With the latest snow and rain pushing through Tennessee, there was nothing new to report in this weeks Drought Monitor.

What's Next? With more rain and cooler temperatures expected in the drought monitoring period (Tuesday to Tuesday), Tennessee will likely continue to be clear on the Drought Monitor.

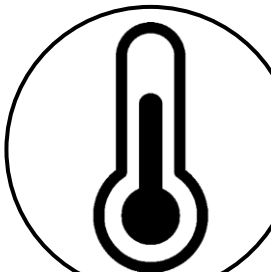

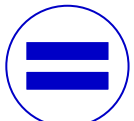
