

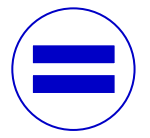
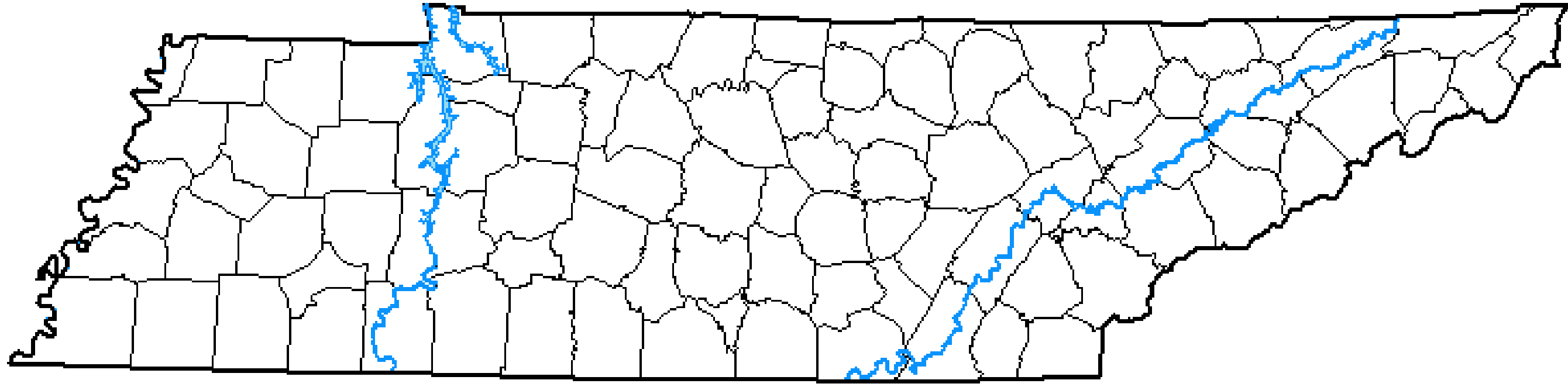
# Tennessee Drought Update

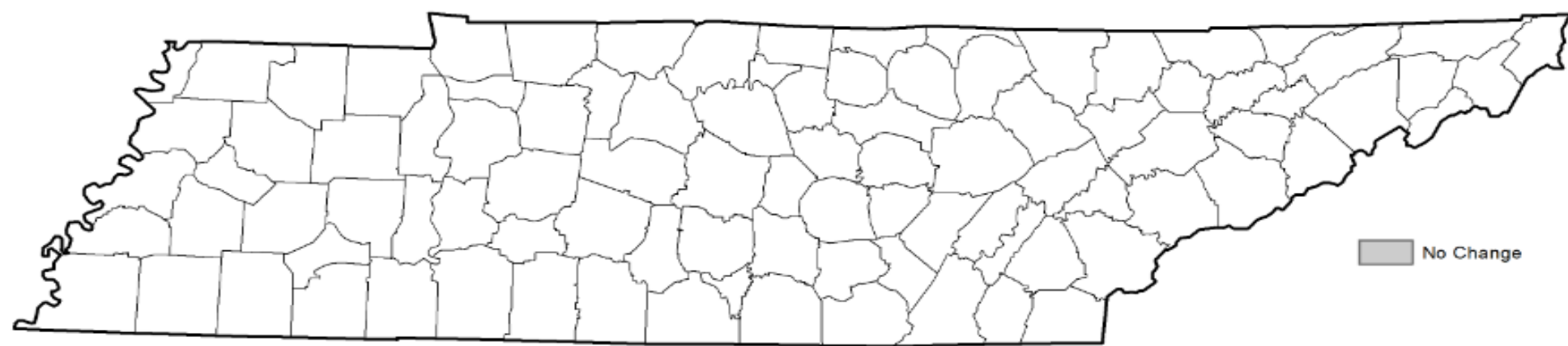
Tennessee remains free of any drought conditions.

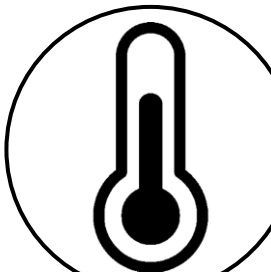

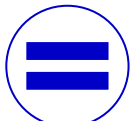
