

TONGUE TIED!

How to Play: Children will take turns trying to say each of the tongue twisters. Keep score of how many you say correctly! Add a timer to the game to see who says it correctly the fastest!

Materials:

- A supply of tongue twisters (below)
- A timer to measure your speed

Tongue Twisters:

- Blue bluebird
- Fresh fried fish
- Fred fed Ted bread and Ted fed Fred bread!
- Betty's big bunny bobbed by the blueberry bush.
- Fuzzy Wuzzy was a bear. Fuzzy Wuzzy had no hair. Fuzzy Wuzzy wasn't fuzzy, was he?
- If a dog chews shoes, whose shoes does he choose?
- Peter Piper picked a peck of pickled peppers; A peck of pickled peppers Peter Piper picked; If Peter Piper picked a peck of pickled peppers, where's the peck of pickled peppers Peter Piper picked.
- How much wood would a woodchuck chuck if a woodchuck could chuck wood? He would chuck, he would, as much as he could, and chuck as much wood as a woodchuck could if a woodchuck could chuck wood.
- Sally sells seashells on the seashore. The shells she sells are seashells, I'm sure, and if she sells seashells on the seashore, then I'm sure Sally sells seashore shells.
- I thought a thought, but the thought I thought wasn't the thought I thought I thought. If the thought I thought I thought had been the thought I thought, I wouldn't have thought that thought!
- Which witch is which?
