Requirements:

The following courses in ENGLISH will be required for adding an endorsement in that field. If the candidate's college transcript shows that he/she has taken any of these courses previously and attained a minimum grade of "B," the requirement is met for those particular courses.

Beginning Proficiency:

Teachers who wish to pursue ENGLISH add-on are expected to enter the program with a minimum of one course or challenge proficiency in the following:

- American Literature, equivalent to our ENGL 2110 or 2120
- British Literature, equivalent to our ENGL 2210 British Lit. I, OR Shakespeare, equivalent to our ENGL 4200 Shakespeare & His Age
- European or World Literature, equivalent to our ENGL 2430 European Literature or ENGL 2330 World Literature

Candidates must show at least a "B" in each of these courses or their equivalents.

- Courses counted toward an add-on must have a minimum grade of "C" (2.0) or equivalent unless otherwise stated in this program sheet.
- Add-ons will not be verified unless all requirements for initial Tennessee teaching license are met.
- This endorsement can be added by coursework only, that is, by completing this add-on endorsement program of study, and does not require passing a content area assessment.
