2. Provide a description of your future goals as a special education teacher or speechlanguage pathologist and how your goals relate to serving students with high intensity support needs (SwHISN; e.g., multiple disabilities, significant cognitive disabilities, significant physical disabilities, significant autism, significant sensory disabilities) in schools.
