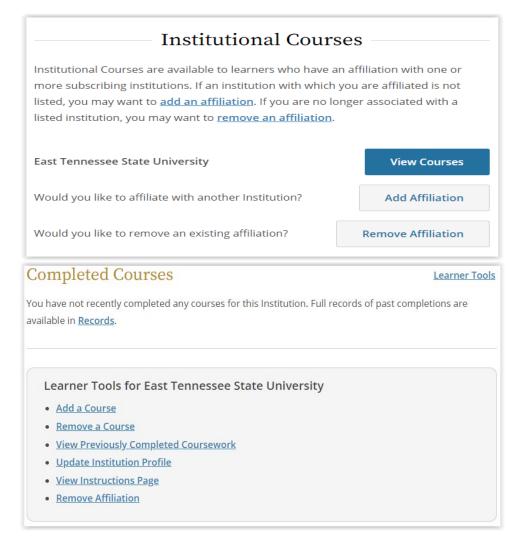
Some students are asked to complete CITI human subjects research training as part of their course or class requirements. These students should complete the "Students in Research" course by following the instructions below.

# First time users of CITI training program

- 1. Go to www.citiprogram.org
- 2. Select REGISTER on the right-hand side.
- 3. Under "Select Your Organizational Affiliation" type **East Tennessee State University**. (Once you begin typing "East," you should see a list of schools and can select from the list). Training will be free of charge.
- 4. Check the 'I Agree' and 'I affirm' box, and continue to create your CITI program username/password.



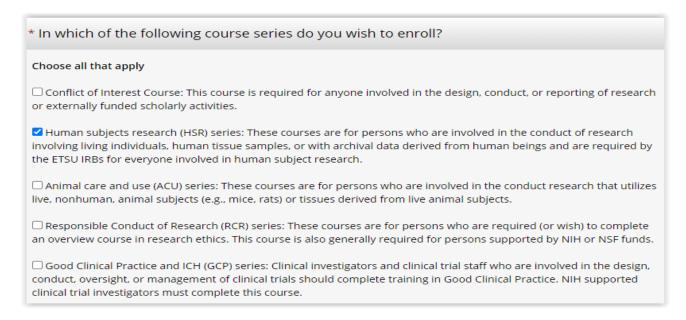
5. <u>Do Not select</u>: Independent Learner Registration as fees will apply.



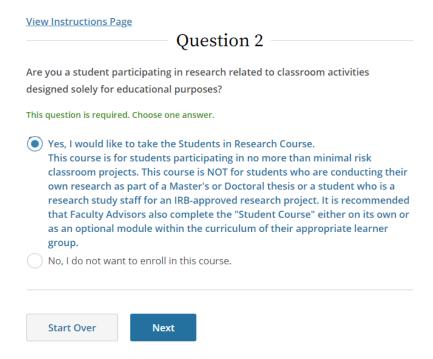
6. Provide the requested information to complete your new user profile.

Follow the instructions below to add the Students in Research course

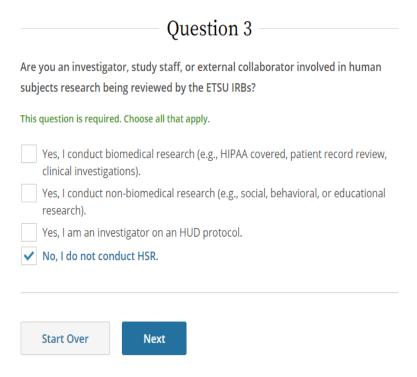
Select Human subjects research (HSR) series.



2. Select "Yes, I would like to take the Students in Research Course.":



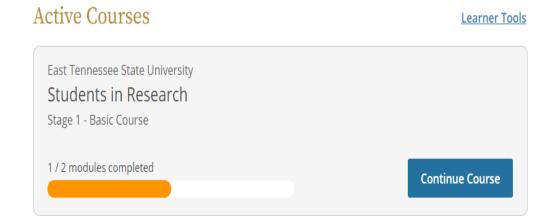
3. If you plan to submit a protocol to the ETSU IRB for review, you would select the appropriate Yes answer. If you are only required to complete the Student in Research course, select No.



4. Select Finalize to complete enrollment. You will automatically be brought to your Courses homepage, which will list any CITI courses that you are enrolled in.



5. To Begin the course(s) you have selected: Select 'START NOW' and 'Agree to the terms of service' and submit.



6. Complete all the required modules within the selected course. All modules in a required course must be completed to earn a certificate.



7. Once you complete the course, click **Access your completion records** in order to save a copy for your records and your Faculty Advisor/Professor as needed.
