Policy Name: Graduate School Admissions Policy for Second or Subsequent Graduate Degree or Certificate

Policy Purpose

This policy specifies the admission process for an applicant who: (1) previously earned a graduate degree or graduate certificate, and (2) is seeking admission to ETSU to pursue an additional graduate degree or certificate.

Applicability

This policy applies to faculty, staff, and students.

Responsible Official, Office, and Interpretation

The Graduate School, College of Graduate and Continuing Studies is responsible for the review and revision of this policy. An applicant who previously earned a graduate degree or graduate certificate and who is seeking admission to earn an additional graduate degree or certificate must apply to the Graduate School pursuant to the <u>Graduate School Admission Degree and Certificate Seeking Students Policy</u>.

An applicant who holds a previously earned graduate degree or graduate certificate may qualify for a reduction in the number of credits required for a subsequent degree. An applicant should review the <u>Graduate School Reduction and/or Substitution of Credits for Subsequent Graduate Degree Policy</u>.
