Meeting Notes

1. Call to Order

President Morelock called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. President Morelock extended congratulations on all newly elected Senators and the Executive Committee. He also thanked all returning Senators for their continued service.

- Athletics Update Tennessee Tech University will become a member of the Southern Conference (SoCon) effective July 1, 2026.
 Football season tickets sales increased for the current season. Total football season ticket sales are approx 250.
- *Enrollment Update* Post-census enrollment numbers increased from Fall 2024 in the following areas: First-time Freshman enrollment (+146), Transfer enrollment (+2), and Dual enrollment (+72).

 Total undergraduate enrollment is 11,260.

- Financial Aid and Admissions Update Transfer students now have access to APS aid through the admissions process. September is Free Application Month; the application fee is waived for Tennessee residents. Senator Strauss clarified that the waived application fee does not pertain to Graduate applications. ETSU is participating in a direct admission program launching in Fall 2025. The DAP will admit any student within eligibility requirements to ETSU and other participating institutions when applicants complete the Tennessee Promise Scholarship application.
