Dear Mr. Bailey:

This letter confirms the results of my review of Lambda Chi Alpha Fraternity's disciplinary appeal, which we discussed in our meeting on April 8, 2015. In a University Judicial Board hearing held on March 19, 2015, Lambda Chi Alpha was found responsible for:

- Disorderly Conduct
- Failure to Cooperate with Institutional Officials
- Hazing
- Providing False Information
- Violation of General Rules and Regulations

After review of the appeal, I am writing to inform you that the finding of the University Judicial Board has been upheld. The seriousness of the violations and repeated offenses by the Chapter warrant a significant period of suspension. The actions of the Chapter have put individuals at risk, are inconsistent with the values of the University, have continued over time, and will not be accepted in our community.

The period of suspension has been amended to four years. On or after March 20, 2019, Lambda Chi Alpha Fraternity will be eligible to submit a plan for recolonization and reinstatement of the Chapter that ensures appropriate oversight and leadership from the alumni and the national organization. The plan must be approved by the University and must follow established Interfraternity Council policies.

If Lambda Chi Alpha chooses to pursue reinstatement upon completion of the period of suspension, the University will conduct a thorough review with alumni leadership and the national organization to ensure that a well-developed and comprehensive recolonization plan is in place.
