The TRIO Bridge application is open to all ETSU Upward Bound participants who will graduate in the 2024-2025 school year. Applicants must have applied and been accepted to East Tennessee State University for the <u>Summer 2025 term</u> in order to participate in the Bridge program.

The Bridge program is intended to:

- Enable participants to experience the demands of college and to develop the skills necessary to succeed in college while under the guidance of Upward Bound staff
- Allow participants to earn college credit

The Bridge program includes payment for tuition and fees at ETSU for up to six (6) credit hours of approved courses, meals throughout the week, books, and needed supplies.

Students participating in the Bridge program are expected to submit a complete and organized application inclusive of all required materials and which reflects their best efforts to present themselves as motivated students who are willing to work to succeed in a postsecondary degree program and who are positive and appropriate role models for their peers.

UPWARD BOUND BRIDGE APPLICATION

The Summer Bridge program was established to assist participants with their transition from high school to college. Provided resources such as academic advising and mentoring help to maintain the focus of the program, which is long-term academic success for the participant.

Seniors who graduate in good standing with Upward Bound are eligible to participate in the Bridge program. Please note that you do not have to continue your education at ETSU after the summer term. You may transfer your credits to the school of your choice.

The program includes:

- Tuition & fees at ETSU up to six (6) credit hours of approved courses
- Books and needed supplies
- Academic and personal mentoring by Upward Bound staff
- Meals in the Dining Hall Monday-Friday

In order to be considered for the Bridge program you must fulfill the following requirements:

- Must have completed all senior year Bridge requirements by the required deadlines (including those in spring semester)
- Must complete an ETSU application for admission and be accepted for the Summer 2025 term
- Must complete the following application in its entirety and return it by **December 13**,
 2024.

The Bridge program will run from June 9th - July 11th with move-in on June 8th and a Bridge-only trip the week of July 14th. Participation in the Bridge program will be determined by Upward Bound staff based upon the criteria listed above as well as academic dedication, past participation in the program, and behavior at school visits, Monday sessions, and past summer sessions.
